WHEREAS, all Louisianians should renew their commitment to conserve our state's air, water, and land for the benefit of future generations.


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bobby Jindal, Governor of the State of Louisiana, do hereby proclaim June 2009 as


GREAT OUTDOORS MONTH
