

# *Executive Proclamation*

## *State of South Dakota Office of the Governor*

*Whereas*, South Dakota is an outdoor recreation destination for families, anglers, hunters, and adventure travelers; and,

*Whereas*, South Dakota's natural resources, state and national parks, and open spaces are recognized as some of the most spectacular, clean, and accessible; and,

*Whereas*, South Dakota leads the way in encouraging families and children into the great outdoors with places such as Game, Fish, and Parks' Outdoor Campuses, Outdoor University events, and programs such as Go Fourth which provides a free daily park entrance license to every fourth grade student in the state; and,

*Whereas*, Today youth spend an average of 10 hours per day in front of a screen, and outdoor activity is touted by leading health organizations as a remedy to the adverse effects caused by increased inactivity; and,

*Whereas*, South Dakota's 13 state parks, 43 recreation areas, 5 nature areas, 1 historic prairie, 69 lakeside use areas, 10 marina/resorts, the 114-mile Mickelson Trail, over 1,500 miles of snowmobile trails, 215 camping cabins, and countless lakes attract millions of visitors each year; and,

*Whereas*, The economic impact of outdoor recreation in South Dakota is estimated at \$1.3 billion and supports some 18,000 jobs; and,

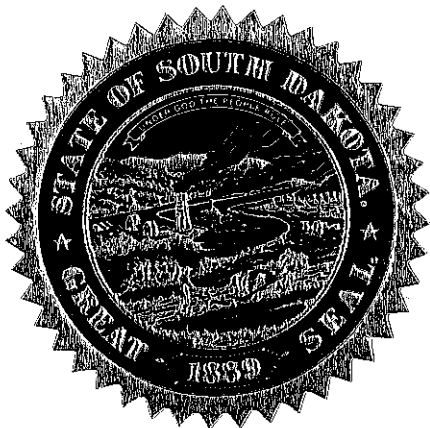
*Whereas*, South Dakota's Great Outdoors is a partnership with federal, state, and local agencies, the recreation and tourism industries, and other non-government organizations who make outdoor opportunities available; and,

*Whereas*, Enjoyment of South Dakota's Great Outdoors allows us to celebrate the commitment of our state to provide access to air, water, wildlife, and lands while protecting it at the same time and contribute to conservation efforts through various licenses, taxes, and fees:
